

Deed from M H Wills and wife
to Samuel Ayres May 13th 1846 ^{ms}

These Indentures made and concluded this 13th of May one thousand eight hundred forty six between M H Wills and Narcisia E. Wills his wife of the one part and Samuel Ayres of the other part: all of Monroe County Va. Witnesseth that the said M H Wills and wife for and in consideration of the sum of seventy five dollars lawful money of Va. to them in hand paid by said Samuel Ayres the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have bargained and sold by these presents do grant bargain & sell unto the said Samuel Ayres his heirs & assigns forever a certain tract or parcel of land containing one hundred acres or the same more or less joining the lands of Jesse Beard and Arthur on the waters of Greenbrier river on Elk Mountain in the County of Monroe Va. To have and to hold all the right and title of the said M. H. Wills and wife, in and to the aforementioned tract or parcel of land to the only proper use and behoof of him to said Samuel Ayres his heirs & assigns forever

And the said Malon H Wills and wife and heirs hereby covenant promise and agree to forever warrant and defend the right and title of said tract of land from themselves their heirs and from all and every person or persons claiming under them but none others In testimony whereof the said M H Wills & wife have hereunto set their hands and seals this day and year first above mentioned
